<u>Conditions to the owner:</u>												
1. Burning of waste wood, block burns, grazing camps and crop residues may only be undertaken when the fire index is less than 45												
2. Firebreaks may only be burned if the fire index is less than 55.												
3. Adequate precautions must be taken, in terms of available manpower and minimum equipment												
4. Neighbours, FPA, Fire Brigade and issuing officer must be notified												
5. The area to be burned must be surrounded by a pre-fire (grazing camps / crop residues / block fires)												
6. You are responsible for ensuring that the fire does not spread to your neighbours.												
7. Do not leave a fire unattended until it is completely extinguished. Make sure the area is patrolled for the next few days.												
8. According to the National Forest & Veldbrand Act (Act 101 of 1998), recklessness is a criminal offense. The CARA law must also be complied with.												
9. When the burning is complete, notify everyone as in point 4.												
10. The issuance of this permit does not indemnify any landowner from his duties, obligations and responsibilities and no liability or debt can not be claimed from APIESRIVIER RURAL FPA, its employees' agents or members.												
11. Prior approvals must be obtained 14 days before the planned date.
